

## P&C President's Report - 16th June 2014

1. Winter Carnival preparations are ramping up.
  - Info has gone off to the printer
  - Finalising all the programs
  - Bring days have been a mixed success and we may have to top up on some things.
  - Rosters are up so now we have to encourage the volunteers. I have applied to Volunteers Qld but we must be accepted first before we can ask for volunteers.
