Bookings

To book Holiday Club Care, families can simply complete the booking form (overleaf), detach and return to the YMCA OSHC service of their choice.

Fee structure and Child Care Benefit

\$43 per child BUT that's before any Child Care Benefit discounts are applied. Some families pay as little as \$2 per day. To ensure the maximum amount of fee reduction is applied families are required to provide dates of birth and Customer Reference Numbers of each child and parents/guardians. Additional activity costs are charge for incursions and excursions.

Don't forget...

Lunch and named waterbottle – please consider our policy regarding peanuts and treenuts when packing lunchboxes.

Hat – sun safety is important to us and we strictly adhere to our policy. Where possible we recommend broad brimmed or legionnaire style hats.

A smile – this is essential to having fun!

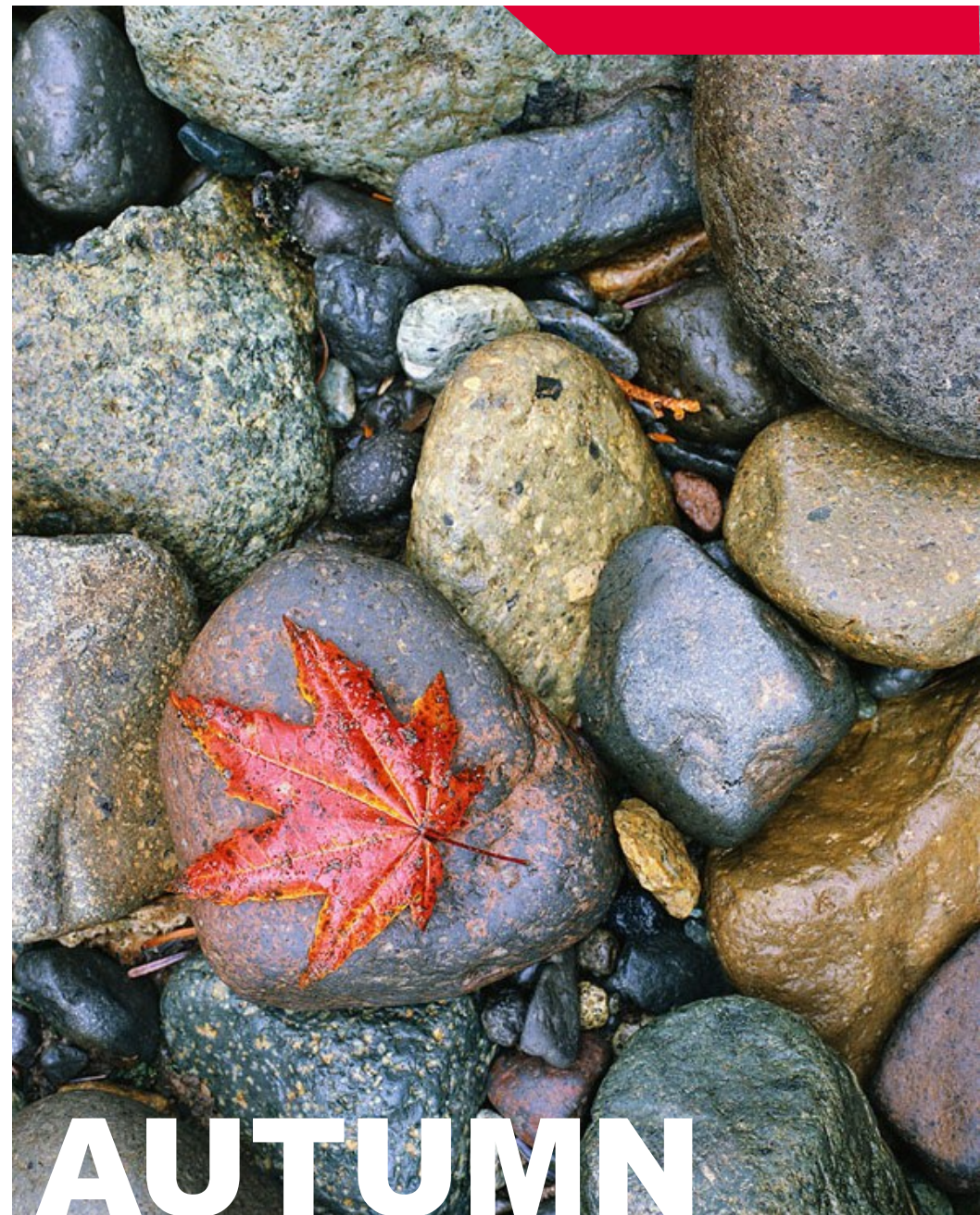
